For creature comforts, please note:

#### **If you wish:**

Bring your own hymn books although words are on the overhead screen.

Bring your own Bible.

Pew cushions are now in situ.

#### **Toilet facilities are now available with mitigations.**

#### **Mandatory:**

Face coverings, (unless you have an exemption)

Singing with face coverings

Now 1 metre rule Physical Distancing (you may be shown to your seat)

Hand sanitising entering and exiting the building

Contact details (taken on entering and time of leaving)

Enter main door – exit top door (one way system)

Avoid car sharing with people outside extended household wherever possible

No 'lifts to church' – unless in family bubble

To observe safe building capacity, our building dictates **30**, therefore please contact:
